

ORDINANCE NO. 1974-2

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE TOWN OF LA JARA

WHEREAS, there has heretofore been presented to the Board of Trustees of the Town of La Jara a written petition for the annexation of the following described property situate in the County of Conejos and State of Colorado, to-wit:

All of VELASQUEZ SUBDIVISION to the Town of La Jara, Conejos County, State of Colorado referring to Lots 1 through and including 23 together with all Right-of-Ways; more specifically described as follows:


A tract of land located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 14 T 35 N R 9 E of the N.M.P.M. Conejos County, Colorado, and being more particularly described as follows: Commencing at a tie at the point of intersection of the centerline of Poplar Street with the North boundary of the Town of La Jara; thence S 78° 02' 00" E along said boundary a distance of 30.0' feet to the point of beginning; thence N 11° 58' 00" E along the East line of Poplar to the County road right-of-way a distance of 498.0' feet; thence S 89° 07' 00" E along said right-of-way a distance of 330.0' feet; thence S 02° 25' 00" W a distance of 566.0' feet to a point on the North boundary of the Town of La Jara from which the center of Sec. 14 bears S 11° 58' 00" W a distance of 462.0' feet more or less; thence N 78° 02' 00" W a distance of 418.0' feet more or less to the point of beginning, and containing 4.56 acres more or less.

AND WHEREAS, such petition was filed in form and manner as required by law and has been accepted by the Board of Trustees.


NOW THEREFORE be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of La Jara, Colorado:
