

ORDINANCE NO. 1975-7

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL SUMS OF MONEY TO DEFRAY EXPENSES IN EXCESS OF AMOUNTS BUDGETED FOR THE TOWN OF LA JARA, COLORADO.

WHEREAS, Certain employees hired by the Town of La Jara, Colorado, were compensated through the Colorado Division of Employment, CETA Title II Funds, up through and including October 17, 1975, of the current budget year and were also retained for the balance of the current budget year, and

WHEREAS, Additional appropriations were not made by the Colorado Division of Employment, CETA Title II Funds, for the remaining balance of the current budget year, and

WHEREAS, the compensation of said employees for the balance of the current budget year has created a deficit in the Executive Account No. 413, and

WHEREAS, deficit spending resulted in the Communicable Diseases Account No. 441.4 as a result of increased expenditures for the purposes of mosquito control, which additional expenditures could not have been reasonably foreseen at the time of the adoption of the budget, and

WHEREAS, increased building maintenance, repair and remodeling expenses will likely create a deficit in the General Government Building and Plant Account No. 419.4, and since such increased expenditures could not have been reasonably foreseen at the time of the adoption of the budget,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LA JARA, COLORADO:

Section 1. That the 1975 appropriation for the Executive Account within the General Fund is hereby increased from \$ 7,635 to \$ 9,635; the 1975 appropriation for the Communicable Diseases Fund within the General Fund is hereby increased from \$ 1,000 to \$ 1,300; and the 1975 appropriation for the General Government Building and Plant Fund within the General Fund is hereby increased from \$ 4,000 to \$ 4,500, all of which shall be payable from within the General Fund out of anticipated balance-end-of-year Unappropriated Surplus in order to eliminate deficit spending or anticipated deficit spending for the remainder of the 1975 budget year.

Section 2. Effective Date.--Whereas, in the opinion of the Board of Trustees of the Town of La Jara, an emergency exists and this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its final passage and publication.

cent (10%) penalty for the cost of collection, in the same manner as other taxes are collected. Any amount so collected shall be remitted to the Town Clerk by the County Treasurer.

Section 11. Penalties.--The following penalties, herewith set forth in full, shall apply to this ordinance:

(a) It is unlawful for any person to violate any of the provisions stated or adopted in this ordinance.

(b) Every person convicted of a violation of any provision stated or adopted in this ordinance shall be punished by a fine not exceeding THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00), or by imprisonment not exceeding ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 12. Severability.--If any provisions of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person, situation, or circumstance be held unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or applications, and the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable, the Board of Trustees of the Town of La Jara expressly declaring that it would have passed this ordinance and every paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase and word thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more of the other paragraphs, subparagraphs, phrases, or words thereof may be declared invalid.

Section 13. Repeal.--Any or all ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Town of La Jara, in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that that the repeal of any ordinance or parts of ordinances of the Town of La Jara shall not revive any other sections of any ordinance or ordinances heretofore repealed or superseded. Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 of "An Ordinance Concerning Garbage, Trash, and Weeds" are hereby specifically repealed in their entirety.

Section 14. Effective Date.--Whereas, in the opinion of the Board of Trustees of the Town of La Jara, an emergency exists and this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its final passage and publication.
