Water and Sewer Info

New water meters have been installed for all businesses/residences located west of Hwy 285. A reminder that these new meters will capture every drop of water that passes through them. Your billing will reflect accurate usage of water. Direct any concerns/questions to the Town Manager.

We ask that if you are using wipes to not flush them. Even if the label says flushable it can still cause issues to rise. Wipes can cause a series of problems such as, septic system problems, sewer back ups, and even cause pipes to burst. "Trash it. Don't Flush it."

ANY BUSINESS OR RESIDENCES THAT HAVE NOT SUBMITTED A RECENT BACK FLOW PREVENTION INSPECTION, PLEASE DO SO BY JULY 18TH. THE TOWN OF LA JARA WILL HAVE SANITARY SURVEY AUDIT AT THE END OF JULY 2022, TO REVIEW ALL SUBMITTED TEST.

WITH THE FOURTH OF JULY APPROACHING, WE WOULD LIKE TO LET EVERYONE KNOW SHERIFF CROWTHER HAS LIFTED THE FIRE BAN EFFECTIVE JUNE 20TH. BUT REMEMBER ON "RED FLAG" DAY THE BAN DOES AUTOMATICALLY GO BACK INTO EFFECT FOR THAT DAY. FOREST SERVICE AND BLM FIRE BANS ARE STILL IN EFFECT YOU CANNOT HAVE A FIRE ON FEDERAL LAND AT THIS TIME.
