2024 Election

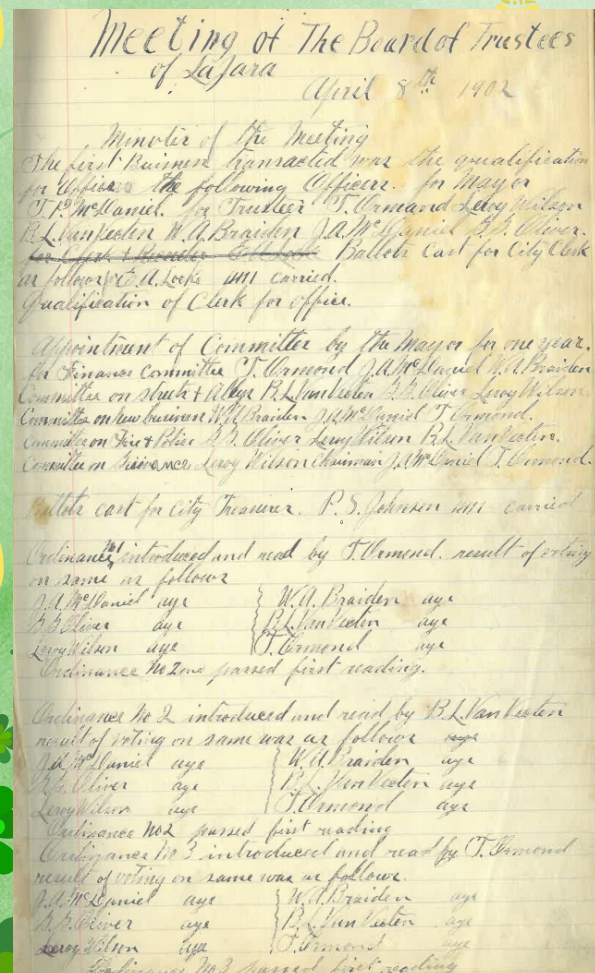
The La Jara Regular Municipal Election will be held on Tuesday, April 2, 2024. This will be a polling place election, meaning that you will have to come and vote in person at La Jara Town Hall, 221 Broadway from 7 am to 7 pm. If you are not able to vote in person on April 2nd you may request an application for an Absentee Ballot by calling La Jara Town Hall at 274-5363.

There will be one question referred to the voters on the ballot. The Board of Trustees are asking voters to consider amending the town code to allow ordinances to be published by title only rather than publishing the entire ordinance in the local newspaper. Publishing ordinances in the newspaper can be rather costly and to reduce the publication costs Colorado Revised Statutes (§31-16-105) provides that citizens can vote to allow for ordinances to be published by title only. All ordinances are always available to view at Town Hall or are available on the website at townoflajara.colorado.gov.
