Even though the packaging may say flushable wipes they are still not safe for sewer lines, since wipes are not made out of materials that can easily be broken down, they do not dissolve and will plug the lines. Remember "Trash it not Flush it."

OH NO!


Things that should never be put down the drain consist of, egg shells, fats, oils, grease, coffee grounds, produce stickers, cleaning products, paint, car fluids, and medications.

Things that should never be flushed consist of, unused drugs or pharmaceuticals, big chunks of waste (sand, plastics, toys, animal parts, cat liter, including flushable cat litter), tampons and sanitary napkins, disposable diapers, fats oil grease, anything radioactive, fertilizer, pesticides, insecticides, herbicides, condoms, flushable wipes, flammable or explosive liquids, solids, gases, automotive chemicals, (antifreeze, coolant, brake fluid, transmission fluid), and paper towels.
